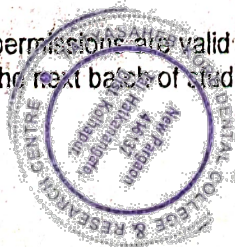
Sir,

In pursuance of orders dated 26.05.2010 and 19.10.2010 in CWP No.4238 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay, I am directed to say that the Dental Council of India in its letter dated 07.12.2010 has informed that its Executive Committee in its meeting held on 29.11.2010 has considered the inspection report conducted by Dr.S.C.Boyar at the petitioner dental college and recommended to the Central Government to grant its permission for starting of MDS course in the speciality of Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics with 2 seats, after obtaining the Performance Bank Guarantee of Rs.60.00 lakhs from the applicant dental college, and also recommended for renewal of 2nd year MDS course in the speciality of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge with 2 seats at the subject dental college for the academic year 2010-11. Further, the Council has stated that the petitioner dental college has already admitted two students each in the above specialities well within the last date even for stay admissions (i.e. 31.05.2010) as prescribed in the DCI Regulations, 2006, as such there is no violation of time schedule in the instant case.

2. The Central Government has accepted the above recommendations of the Dental Council of India and accordingly permission of the Central Government is granted to Tatyasaheb Kore Dental College & Research Centre, Distt., Kolhapur for renewal of 2nd year MDS course in the speciality of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge with 2 seats for the academic year 2010-11. Since the petitioner dental college has already submitted the Performance Bank Guarantee No.0925IPEBG100003 dated 29.05.2010 for Rs.60.00 lakhs issued by the Bank of India in pursuance of order dated 26.05.2010 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No.4238, the formal Permission of the Central Government under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 is hereby granted to Tatyasaheb Kore Dental College & Research Centre, Distt., Kolhapur for starting of MDS course in the speciality of Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics with 2 seats from the academic session 2010-11.

3.
